Option 2: Hauraki Gulf Eco Sailing Experience with Terra and Tide

Visit our pest-free Motukorea island for a guided walk, with opportunities for swimming, snorkelling and stand-up paddleboarding, followed by a catered lunch.

Hear from your local guide on the Hauraki Gulf Marine Park, its islands, history and people. You'll learn about the oceanography of the Gulf, the resident and migratory species which make the Gulf their home and current conservation efforts on land and sea while gliding along with the wind.
